Know all Men by these Presents, That we Dell Stuart and Nettie H. Stuart, husband and wife, in consideration of One Dollar, to us paid by Henry W. Coe do hereby remise, release and forever Quitclaim unto the said Henry W. Coe and unto his heirs and assigns all our right, title and interest in and to the following described parcel of real estate, situate in County of Skamania State of Washington, to-wit:

All our right, title and interest, and all the right, title and interest of either of us, in and to that certain mining claim situated in Saint Helens District in said County and State, particularly described as follows, to-wit: Being fifteen hundred feet (1500 ft.) linear on the Chicago Lode, beginning at the terminus of the Chicago discovery claim and running fifteen hundred (1500) linear feet in a North Westerly direction and three hundred (300) feet on each side of the center of the vein. This claim is situated fifteen hundred (1500) feet North Westerly of and adjoining the original discovery claim, near the head of the North Toutle River.

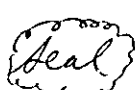
