Notice is hereby given that Thomas M. Roberts of Hood River County, State of Oregon, claims a lien upon a quantity of saw logs, being about 596,000 Board Feet in quantity, which were cut or manufactured in Skamania County, State of Washington, are marked thus: Z-16, and are now lying in Township 4 North, Range 9 & 10 E.W.M., Skamania County, State of Washington, and premises the location of which are presently unknown, for labor performed upon and assistance rendered in falling and cutting said saw logs; that the name of the owner or reputed owner is Pacific Lumber & Shipping, Inc., and/or Leaning Tree Logging, Inc.; that Holger Jensen, President of Leaning Tree Logging employed said Thomas M. Roberts to perform such labor and render such assistance upon the following terms and conditions, to-wit:

The said Holger Jensen agreed to pay the said Thomas M. Roberts for such labor and assistance \$7.00 per thousand board feet; that said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of said Thomas M. Roberts, who performed labor upon and assisted in falling and cutting said saw logs for the period of October 18, 1978 through December 18, 1978; and the rendition of said service was closed on the 18th day of December, 1978, and thirty days

have not elapsed since that time; that the amount of claimant's demand for said service is \$2,645.85; that no part thereof has been paid except \$500.00, and there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon, after deducting all just credits and offsets, the sum of \$2,145.85, in which amount he claims a lien upon said saw logs. The said Thomas M. Roberts also claims a lien on all said saw logs now owned by said Pacific Lumber & Shipping, Inc., and/or Leaning Tree Logging, Inc., of said county to secure payment for the work and labor performed in obtaining or securing the said logs, herein described.

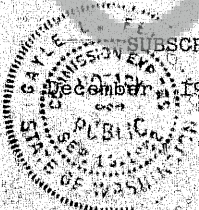
