Know All Men by these presents, That I, Maud Kollock, of Underwood, Skamania County, Washington, have made, constituted and appointed, and by these presents do make, constitute and appoint W. G. McVay, of Underwood, Washington, my true and lawful attorney for me and in my name, place and stead, and for my use and benefit, to collect and receive all sums of money, debts and demands whatsoever, as are now or shall hereafter become due, owing or payable, or belong to me, and have and use all lawful ways and means, in my name or otherwise, for the recovery thereof, and to execute and deliver sufficient discharges for the same, for me and in my name; to bargain, and purchase real or personal property and make payment therefor; to sell, remise, release, convey, and mortgage lands and or personal property, upon such terms and conditions and under such covenants, as he shall think fit;

And especially to do and perform all things necessary to properly carry out such provisions as he may deem necessary to properly care for my ranch in Skamania County, Washington, by borrowing money thereon, if necessary, with which to pay operating expenses; to collect moneys due me and to perform such other acts as to him seems best for me and my property.

Giving and granting unto my said attorney full power and authority to do and perform all and every act and thing whatsoever requisite and necessary to be done in and about the premises, as fully to all intent and purpose as I might or could do if personally present; hereby ratifying and confirming all that my said attorney shall lawfully do or cause to be done by virtue of these presents.
