Lee, do hereby remise, release and forever Quitclaim unto the said Henry H. Lee and unto his heirs and assigns all our right, title and interest in and to the following described parcel of real estate, situate in Skamania County, State of Washington, to-wit:

An undivided one-thirty second interest in and to a certain mining claim known as the Chicago Northwest Discovery (quartz) Mining claim -

Said interest was quitclaimed to said H. A. Anderson by J. M. Broadbent on Sept. 13, 1899 and recorded in the office of the County Auditor of Skamania Co. on Sept. 13, 1900. on page 459 Book 7 of Book of Deeds - and said Chicago North West Discovery claim was re-located at a later date -

Said claim is described as follows: Fifteen hundred (1500) linear feet on the Chicago Lode, situated in the St. Helens Mining District. Beginning at the terminus of the Chicago Discovery claim and running fifteen hundred feet linear (1500) in a North Westerly direction and three hundred (300) feet on each side of center of vein. This claim is situated (1500) feet northwesterly of and adjoining the original discovery claim (Chicago) near the head of the North Tualle River. The South East end center stake is about fifty feet from the opening of the tunnel on this claim, being south east of said opening. It is about the same distance from the tunnel to the Broadbent cabin which said cabin is near the said center end post. This said claim is about 1/4 mile north westerly of the north Tualle river, is about one mile westerly from Bismark Mountain, is about 8 miles northerly from Mt. St. Helens - Said claim being in the St. Helens Mining District.
