Know All Men by these Presents,

That We, Frank Wilmot, Maude E. Wilmot of the County of Multnomah of the State of Oregon in consideration of one dollar to me in hand paid by F. M. Quinn of Skamania County, Washington the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged do hereby remise, release and forever Quit-Claim unto the said F. M. Quinn and unto his heirs and assigns all our right, title and interest in and to the following described premises, namely:

The Michiel Mine, commencing at this post and notice of discovery which is on the Blue Jacket Creek about Two hundred and fifty yards up from where said Creek flows into the Blue Bird Creek and about five hundred feet below the Blue Jacket Mining shaft and tunnel the center line of said claim runs in a north west course crossing the Blue Bird Creek in about one thousand feet from discovery and just below a falls on said creek and just above a stream that flows in on the north side of the Blue Bird creek. This claim is 1500 linear feet in a north west course from this post and notice and three hundred feet wide on the east side of center line and 250 feet wide on the west side of center line or join the Kikipo mining claim and on the south by the Patrick mining claim, and includes all dips, spurs and angles in side of said boundary line, situated in Bald Mountain Mining District in Skamania Co. Washington.

To have and to hold the same unto the said F. M. Quinn and unto his heirs and assigns forever, with all the privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging, free from all claim thereon on the part of the said Frank Wilmot or anyone claiming the same by, or under him in any manner whatsoever.
