This is to certify that No. Major Ransom Harris, Fireman as a "Testimonial of Fidelity and Obedience" to honorably discharged from the U.S.N. Rect. Sta. and from the Naval Service of the United States, this 24 day of August 1919, at Denver Colo.

Now according to the provisions of section 1476 (as amended by Act of Congress approved August 23, 1912) of the Revised Statutes, if within four months from this date the said Major Ransom Harris shall present this, his honorable discharge, at any United States Naval Rendezvous, and is found physically qualified, and shall reenlist for four years, then he shall be entitled to pay during the said four months equal to that to which he would have been entitled had he been employed in state service.

Upon reenlistment, and the surrender of this discharge, should he so desire, he will receive a Continues Service Certificate, showing his service and honorable discharge, and shall receive an addition of one dollar and thirty-two cents per month to the pay of the rating in which he enlists or to which he may be promoted and reduced satisfactory evidence of U.S. Citizenship.
