This is to certify that No. Major Ransom Harris, a Fireman as a "Testimonial of Fidelity and Obedience" is honorably discharged from the U.S.S. Recruit Sta. and from the Naval Service of the United States, this 24 day of August 1919, at Denver Colo.

Now according to the provisions of Section 144 (as amended by Act of Congress approved August 22, 1912) of the Revised Statutes, if within four months from this date the said Major Ransom Harris shall present this, his honorable discharge, at any United States Naval Rendezvous, and is found physically qualified, and shall reenlist for four years, then he shall be entitled to pay during the said four months equal to that to which he would have been entitled had he been employed in such service.

Upon reenlistment, and the occurrence of this discharge, should he so desire, he will receive a Continuity Service Certificate, showing his service and honorable discharge, and shall receive an addition of one dollar and thirteen cents per month to the pay of the rating in which he enlists or to which he may be promoted in reduced category evidence of U.S. Citizenship.
