Quit Claim.

The Grantor R. A. Hill - single - for and in consideration of Fifty Dollars in hand paid, convey and quit claim to F. M. Quinn, all interest in the following described mine situated in Skamania County, State of Washington, to-wit:

The Pacific mine - also known as the Michiel Mine - commencing at the Post and Notice of Discovery which is on the Blue Jacket Creek about 250 yards up from where said creek flows into the Blue Bird Creek and about 500 feet below the Blue Jacket Mining shaft and tunnel - The center line of said claim runs in a North West course crossing the Blue Bird Creek in about 1000 feet from discovery and just below a stream that flows in on the North side of the Blue Bird Creek, and extends 1500 feet. The claim is 300 feet wide on East side of said line and 200 feet wide on the West side of said line, bounded on West by Kiskipoo mine, and on South by Patrick Mine, including all dips, spurs, and angles within said boundary line.
