Know all Men by these Presents, That we, Charles Vogel and Bessie Vogel, his wife, of Skye, of the County of Okamania, in the State of Washington, for and in consideration of the sum of Four Hundred and Fifty Dollars, to us in hand paid by the Okamania Logging Company, a corporation duly incorporated under the laws of Oregon, of the City of Portland, Multnomah County, Oregon, the receipt whereof we do hereby acknowledge we have granted, bargained and sold, and do by these presents, grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said Okamania Logging Company, a corporation, and to its successors and assigns forever, all of that certain tract of land lying and being in the County of Okamania, in State of Washington, and particularly described as follows, to-wit:

The South East quarter of Section Six, in Township Two North of Range Five East of Willamette meridian, containing one hundred and sixty acres.

Together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining, and all of our right, title, interest, claim, possession or demand of any kind whatever, whether at law or equity, of, in, or to the above described premises, and each and every part and parcel thereof.

To have and to hold, the same unto the said Okamania Logging Company and to its successors and assigns forever, and we do hereby covenant with the said grantee its successors and assigns, that at the date hereof we are well seized in fee simple of the premises above conveyed, and we will and our heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the title thereto against the lawful claims or demands of any person or persons whomsoever.
