Know all Men by these Present, That we David W. Hutchinson, Bernice Hutchinson man and wife Walter S. Pedell, E. Engelson & Anna Engelson man and wife, J. A. Hutchinson & L. J. Hutchinson, man and wife and Floyd Hutchinson, all of Clarke County Washington in consideration of Three Thousand (\$3,000) Dollars, to them paid by F. A. Mabee do hereby remise, release and forever Quitclaim unto the said F. A. Mabee and unto his heirs and assigns all our right, title and interest in and to the following described parcel of real estate, situate in Skamania County State of Washington, to-wit:

The "Twin Baby" mining claim, located in Short Creek, a tributary of Blue Bird Creek in Bald Mountain Mining District, and being in the S.W. 1/4 of Sec. 11 T. 3 N. R. 5 E.; commencing at a shaft on East and West line between Secs 11 & 14 T. 3 N. R. 5 E. and 1200 feet East of N.W. corner of Section 14 & N.W. corner of Section 11 and running Northwesterly from said discovery shaft 1500 feet in length to N.W. end of center line and 600 feet in width being 300 feet each side of centre line.

Also the "Prize Baby" mining claim adjoining the "Twin Baby" on the southeast and commencing at discovery shaft on East and West line of Secs 11 and 14. T. 3. N. R. 5 E. and running 1275 feet in length South-easterly to N.W. end of Condor claim and 600 feet in width being 300 feet on each side of centre line.

Also the " " mining claim commencing at the Northwest end of the "Moonlight" claim on Short Creek, Bald Mountain Mining District in N.W. 1/4 of Sec. 14 T. 3 N.
