THE UNITED STATES ARMY, AS A TESTIMONIAL OF HONEST AND FAITHFUL SERVICE, IS HEREBY HONORABLY DISCHARGED FROM THE MILITARY SERVICE OF THE UNITED STATES BY REASON OF MASTER OUT TELEGRAM A.G.O. NOV. 15 1918.

SAID HOWELL V. BROWN WAS BORN IN ST PAUL, IN THE STATE OF MINNESOTA WHEN ENLISTED HE WAS 30 2 YEARS OF AGE AND BY OCCUPATION A STENOGRAPHER HE HAD BROWN EYES, BROWN HAIR, FAIR COMPLEXION, AND WAS 5 FEET 8 INCHES IN HEIGHT.
