Mellinger, a private #3,644,588 of Company K Seventy-fifth Regiment of Infantry United States Army, who was enlisted on the twenty-first day of July, one thousand nine hundred and eighteen to serve for period of the emergency was discharged from the service of the United States on the twenty-fourth day of January, one thousand nine hundred and nineteen by reason of telegram A. G. O. Jan. 6, 1919. Character excellent.
