Certificate in Lieu of Lost or Destroyed Discharge Certificate.

To all whom it may Concern:

Know ye, That Ellis E. Mellinger, a private #3,644,588 of Company K Seventy-fifth Regiment of Infantry United States Army, who was enlisted on the twenty-first day of July, one thousand nine hundred and eighteen to serve for period of the emergency was discharged from the service of the United States on the twenty-fourth day of January, one thousand nine hundred and nineteen by reason of telegram A. G. O. Jan. 6, 1919. Character excellent.

This certificate is given under the provisions of the Act of Congress approved July 1, 1902, "To authorize the Secretary of War to furnish certificates in lieu of lost or destroyed discharges," to homorably discharged officers or enlisted men or their widows upon evidence that the original discharge certificate has been lost or destroyed, and upon the condition imposed by said Act that this certificate "shall not be accepted as a voucher for the rayment of any obvin against the United States for pay, bounty, or other allowances, or as evidence in any other case."

Seal), two years at least before his admission, that i was, bong Fide his intention to become a Citizen of the United States, and to renounce forever, all allegiance to any forsign Prince, Potentate, State or Sovereignty whatsoever and particularly to the King of Switzerland, whom he was heretofore a subject. And said applicant having declarse or eath before this Court that he will support the Constitution of the United States, and that he doth absolutely and entirely renounce and abjure all allegiance and fidelity to every foreign Prince, Fotentate, State or Sovereignty whatsoever, and particularly to the Republic of Switzerland, which he was a subject. The Court being satisfied that said applicant has resided within the United States for the term of five years next preceding his admission, without being at any time during the said five years out of the territory of the United States, and within this State one year at least, and it further appearing to the Satisfaction of this Court that during that time he has behaved as a san of good moral Character, attached to the principles of the Constitution of the United States, and well disposed to the good order and happiness of the same.

Thereupon the Court admitted the said Frederick Zurcher to become a Citizen of the United States and ordered all proceedings aforesaid to be entered of record which was accordingly done by the Clerk of this Court.
