The Court being satisfied that said applicant has resided within the United States for the term of five years next preceding his admission, without being at any time during the said five years out of the territory of the United States, and within this State one year at least, and it further appearing to the Satisfaction of this Court that during that time he has behaved as a san of good moral Character, attached to the principles of the Constitution of the United States, and well disposed to the good order and happiness of the same.

Thereupon the Court admitted the said Frederick Zurcher to become a Citizen of the United States and ordered all proceedings aforesaid to be entered of record which was accordingly done by the Clerk of this Court.
