This Indenture Witnesseth that O. F. Inman and Mary Jane Inman his wife, in consideration of Five hundred (\$500.00) Dollars to them paid in hand, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained, sold and conveyed, and by these presents do bargain, sell and convey unto Ash & Attwell the following described premises, to wit: Beginning at the N. E. corner of the S. W. quarter of the S. E. quarter of Section 25 Twp 3 N. R. 3 W. M. running thence West 66 rods and 6 ft to County Road, thence along meander of County Road to South line of said quarter of quarter section, thence east 14 rods & 13 ft to S. E. corner of said 40 acre tract; thence North 80 rods to place of beginning; also the West half of the Northeast quarter of Northeast quarter of Section Thirty-six (36) Twp. three North Range seven East of N. M. in Skamania County State of Washington, containing thirty-nine acres, more or less, together with the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining.
