Mabel J. Fosse being first duly sworn says: I am County Auditor of Skamania County, Washington and ex-officio clerk of the Board of County Commissioners of said County. I have made a search of the records and files of Board of Commissioners, for the purpose of ascertaining and placing permanently of record the facts pertaining to the said incorpora-

tion as found among the files in my office.

Among the files of the Commissioners Proceedings for December 2, 1907 I found the original petition for incorporation which I have marked Exhibit A am transcribing herewith. No affidavit of publication of Notice of Hearing before the Board of County Commissioners was found but I have inspected the files of the Skamania County Pioneer, the only newspaper published within Skamania County at the time of such incorporation and find that notice of such hearing was published in said paper for a period of three consecutive weeks, commencing October 24, 1907. A true copy of said notice as published in the said newspaper in each of the issues for October 24, 1907, October 31, 1907 and November, 7, 1907 is transcribed as part of this record as Exhibit B.

No affidavit of publication of Notice of Election was found among the files but from a similar inspection of the files of the Skamania County Pioneer I have ascertained that such notice was published for a period of 3 consecutive weeks, to-wit: on the 14th day of November 1907, on the 21st day of November 1907 and on the 28th day of November 1907, A true copy of the said notice is transcribed herewith as Exhibit C.

The Commissioners minutes with reference to such incorporation are found at page 84 of Volume 2 of Commissioners proceedings for Skamania County.

"Be it remembered that the honorable board of Commissioners for Skamania County, Washington met in adjourned session. Present: C. H. Comwell, John Skuar and A. Fleischhauer, Clerk. Commissioner from the First District being absent. The Commissioners proceeded to canvass the returns of the election held on Nov. 1st, 1907. EXHIBIT "B"

"To the Board of Commissioners, Skamania County, Washington.
In the matter of the incorporation of Stevenson.
Honorable Gentlemen:

We, the undersigned, respectfully petition your Honorable Board for the incorporation as a municipal corporation of the fourth class as provided by laws of the State of Washington, March 27, 1890, and subsequent legislation, of that portion of Skamania County, Washington as is hereinafter described, containing less than one square mile.

Your petitioners respectfully represent that said portion of Skamania County contains more than the required population for the incorporation of towns of the fourth class; to-wit: about 379 people within the boundaries hereinafter described.

That your petitioners, are all qualified electors of Skamania County, Stevenson precinct, State of Washington, and are residents within the boundaries hereinafter
