

William Hollis & wife to Storay Keeler Lumber Co.

Know all men by These Presents, That we, William Hollis and Mary A. Hollis (husband and wife) of Skamania Co., State of Washington are held and firmly bound unto Storay Keeler Lumber Co. of La Crosse Wis in the sum of Twelve hundred and fifty (\$1250⁰⁰) Dollars, to be paid to the said William Hollis his executors, administrators or assigns; for which payment well and truly to be made we bind ourselves our heirs, executors and administrators firmly by these presents. Sealed with our seals and dated the 22^d Day of January A.D. 1901.

The Conditions of this obligation are such that if the above bounden obligor shall, on or before the issuance of the patent on the lands hereinafter described make, execute and deliver unto the said Storay Keeler Lumber Co, a Warrantee Deed (provided that the said Storay Keeler Lumber Co shall on or before that day have paid to the said obligor the sum of Twelve hundred and fifty (\$1250⁰⁰) Dollars, Lawfull Money of the United States of America being the purchase price agreed on, a good and sufficient warrantee deed, of all the certain lot, piece or parcel of land, situate in the County of Skamania and State of Washington and bounded and described as follows, to-wit:



The West $\frac{1}{2}$ of the South East $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section ten (10): - and the North East $\frac{1}{4}$ of the North West $\frac{1}{4}$ and the North West $\frac{1}{4}$ of the North East $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section Fifteen (15) in Township four (4) North of Range seven (7) East of Willamette meridian containing one hundred and sixty acres and shall thereby convey the title in fee simple of said premises free and clear of all encumbrances, to the said Storay Keeler Lumber Co. Then this obligation shall be void; otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.
