At a regular meeting of the Executive Committee of Pacific Indemnity Company, called and held at the office of the Company in the City of Los Angeles, on the 8th day of February 1936, the following resolution was adopted:

"RESOLVED, that the President or any Vice-President may from time to time appoint Resident Vice-Presidents, Resident Assistant Secretaries and Attorneys-in-Fact to represent and act for and on behalf of the Company, and either the President, or any Vice-President, the Board of Directors or the Executive Committee may at any time remove any such Resident Vice-President, or Resident Assistant Secretaries and Attorneys-in-Fact and revoke the power and authority given him."
