CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For rights perfect under original, enlargement or secondary permits.)
(In accordance with the provision of Chapter 117, Laws of Washington for 1917, and the regulations of the State Supervisor of Hydraulics thereunder.)

THIS IS TO CERTIFY, that K. P. Cecil, Supervisor, Columbia National Forest of Vancouver, State of Washington, has made proof to the satisfaction of the State Supervisor of Hydraulics of Washington, of a right to the use of the waters of Unnamed spring, for the purposes of Supply for Spirit Lake Ranger Station and public camp ground under Appropriation Permit No. 2373 issued by the State supervisor of Hydraulics, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Washington, and is hereby confirmed by the State Supervisor of Hydraulics of Washington and entered of record in Volume 2, at Page 995, on the 8th day of May, 1937, that the right hereby confirmed dates from April 15, 1936; that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.2 cubic feet per second.
