On or before October 13, 1907 for value received I promise to pay to A. H. & Atwell or order, the sum of One hundred & fifty Dollars, with interest at the rate of 8 per cent per annum. If the interest is not paid when due it shall become compounded with the principal and bear like interest, principal and interest payable in United States Gold coin, and in case suit is instituted to collect this note, or any portion thereof I promise to pay such additional sum at the Court may adjudge reasonable as attorneys fees, to be taxed as part of such suit, for the use of plaintiff attorney.

Now if the sum of money due upon said promissory note be paid according to the agreements herein expressed this conveyance shall be void, but in case default be made in the principal or interest as herein provided then the said A. H. & Atwell or their legal representatives may sell the premises above described, with all and every of the appurtenances, or any part thereof, as the same provided by law, and out of the money arising from such sale, retain the said principal and interest, together with the costs and charges of making such sale, and the overplus, if any then be, pay over to the said Joseph Headruth, his heirs and assigns.
