

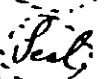

Now it is agreed by said mortgagors that if the mortgagee be compelled to foreclose this mortgage by reason of any breach of the agreements herein contained, the mortgagors shall be entitled to a reasonable attorney's fee in said suit or action, and the mortgagors agree to pay said sum of money hereby incurred and agree that a deficiency judgment may be had against said mortgagors in a suit or action to foreclose this mortgage by the holder of the aforesaid note, or he may waive his security and recover directly upon said note.
