

described as follows: Beginning at discovery near a small cascade on north fork of the Toutle River about $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile from its beginning, said cascade being a part of a large cascade or fall at the top of which is the Esther Mary mine claim location and about 300 feet below the Christobel mining cabin and about $\frac{1}{4}$ of a mile above the separation of the Spirit Lake and Lewis River trails and extends 1500 feet in a south easterly direction, or about 18° east of south, and is 300 feet in width on each side of the center line of said claim and is a relocation of the Copley claim located July 13, 1894. It extends the Octavia above described. It was relocated September 16, 1899, the location notice of which was recorded Dec. 12 1899 in book 8 miscellaneous records of said Auditor's office page 461; the original location notice of the Copley mine is recorded in Miscellaneous record page 179, of said Auditor's office. Also that certain mine known as the Esther Mary mine and is 1500 linear feet along the course of the lead, lode or vein, and three hundred feet in width on each side of the middle of said vein or lode, situated in the St. Helens mining district, county of Skamania, state of Washington, and more particularly described as follows, to-wit: Commencing at discovery on the south east terminal branch of the North Fork of the Toutle River and just above a large Cascade and extends fifteen hundred feet along the course of said vein in a north easterly direction with three hundred feet on each side of the middle of said vein and known as the Esther Mary mine. The location notice of the above is recorded in the Auditor's office of said County in book of miscellaneous records page 105. Also all dips, spurs and angles, and also all the metals, ores, gold silver and mineral bearing quartz, rock and earth therein and all the rights privileges and franchises thereto incident appendant and appurtenant, or therewith usually had and enjoyed, and also all and singular the tenements therewith usually had and enjoyed, and also all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining; and also all the estate, right, title, interest, property possession, claim and demand whatsoever as well in law as in equity of the said undivided one-half interest in the said properties and mining
