Know all Men by these Presents, That George W. Fisher and his wife Lillian B. Fisher of the County of Multnomah in the State of Oregon, for and in consideration of the sum of Thirty five and ⁰⁰/₁₀₀ Dollars, to us in hand paid by Charles Myers of the County of Skamania, State of Washington the receipt whereof we do hereby acknowledge we have granted, bargained and sold, and do by these presents, grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said Charles Myers and to his heirs and assigns forever, all of that certain Tract of land lying and being in the County of Skamania, State of Washington, and particularly described as follows, to-wit:

The South East $\frac{1}{4}$ of the North East $\frac{1}{4}$ of the South East $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section Twenty-two (22), Township 4 North of Range 9 East of Willamette Meridian, and containing ten (10) acres.

Together with all and singular the Tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining, and all of our right, title, interest, claim, possession or demand of any kind whatever, whether at law or equity, of, in or to the above described premises, and each and every part and parcel thereof except the timber standing and growing thereon as hereby agreed, said timber being reserved and remaining the property of said Geo. W. Fisher wife.

To have and to hold, the same unto the said Charles Myers and to his heirs and assigns forever we do hereby covenant with the said grantee his heirs and assigns, that at the date hereof we well seized in fee simple of the premises above conveyed, and we will and our heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the title thereto against the lawful claims or demands of any person or persons whomsoever.
