Wing of Skamania County, State of Washington do hereby sell and convey unto the said Lacy E. Wing and to his heirs and assigns, the following described premises, situated in the County of Skamania, and State of Washington, to wit:

Commencing at a point $27\frac{50}{100}$ chains from the S.W. corner of Section 17, Township 1, North of R. 5. E. of the Willamette Meridian, running thence North 24 chains to a point $12\frac{50}{100}$ chains West of the North and South line through the center of said Sec. 17; thence East $12\frac{50}{100}$ chains to said N. & S. line, thence South 24 chains to the quarter post upon the South side of said Sec. 17, thence West $12\frac{50}{100}$ chains to the place of beginning, containing thirty acres,

And we do hereby covenant with the said Lacy E. Wing that we are lawfully seized of said premises; that they are free from incumbrance; that we have good right and lawful authority to sell and convey the same, and we do hereby covenant to warrant and defend the said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever; and the grantors aforesaid hereby relinquishes all contingent rights, including right of dower, which they may have in and to the said described premises.

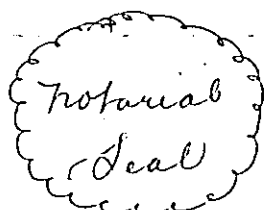
