The condition of the aforegoing obligation is such, that Whereas, the said Principal was elected on November 8, 1938, to the office of CLERK OF SUPERIOR COURT of the County of Skamania, State of Washington, to begin her term of office on January 9, 1939, and ending the second Monday in January, 1943.

Now, therefore, if the said principal shall faithfully perform the duties of her office as now provided by law and as may be provided by any law hereinafter enacted, and account for and pay over all moneys which may come into her hands by virtue of her office, and that she, her executors or administrators will deliver to her successor, safe and undamaged, all books, records, papers, seals, apparatus and furniture belonging to her office, then this obligation shall be null and void; it is otherwise to be and remain in full force and virtue.
