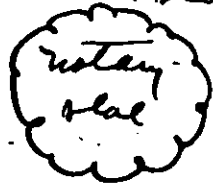

This Indenture Witnesseth that Frank Anderson, unmarried, in consideration of Nine Hundred Fifty-two to him paid in hand, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained sold and conveyed and by these presents do bargain, sell and convey unto Edward Anderson the following described premises, to-wit: The undivided one third of the following described premises, Commencing at a point Seven Hundred Forty-two feet South and Fifty feet East of the Northwest corner of the Northeast quarter of the Southeast quarter of Section Twenty-nine, Township Three North Range Eight East Willamette Meridian, and running East One Hundred feet, thence South One Hundred feet, thence West One Hundred feet thence North One Hundred to point of beginning, in Skamania County, Washington containing one lot One Hundred feet square, together with the covenants, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining. To have and to hold the same ^{with} the appurtenances unto the said Edward Anderson his heirs and assigns forever.

This conveyance is intended as a mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Nine Hundred Fifty-two dollars, and the interest thereon, in accordance with the tenor of a certain promissory note of which the following is a copy, to-wit:
