

Christopher Cole & Wife to Copper Creek Mining Co.

Witnesseth, that the said parties of the first part, for the consideration of the sum of \$1.00 to them in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof, is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents, remise, release and forever quitclaim unto the said party of the second part, its successors and assigns, all that certain mining ground, claims or lodes, situated, lying, and being in the Copper Creek Mining District, Skamania County, Washington, described as follows: -

All, of the "Big Elephant" lode or mining claim, located by C. Cole, and recorded on the — day of — on Page 48 in Book "C" Miscellaneous Records.

Also the "Yellowbird" lode or mining claim located by C. Cole, and recorded on the — day of — on page 47 in Book "C" Miscellaneous Records.
