Schock and to her heirs and assigns forever, all timber standing and growing on that certain tract of land lying and being in the County of Skamania, State of Washington, and particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at a stake at the N.W. cor of the S.W. 1/4 of the N.W. 1/4 of Sec. 1, thence east eighty rods (80), thence south thirty (30) rods, thence west eighty (80) rods, thence north thirty (30) rods to place of beginning and containing fifteen (15) acres all in the S.W. 1/4 of the N.W. 1/4 of section one (1) Township No. (3) three North of Range No. (9) run east of Willamette Meridian, and all of our right, title, interest, claim, possession or demand of any kind whatever, whether at law or equity, of, in, or to the above described timber with free access thereto over above described land, and three (3) years time is hereby granted for the removal of said timber.

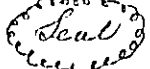
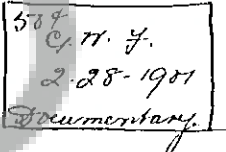
