(In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 117, Laws of Washington for 1917, and the regulations of the State Supervisor of Hydraulics ther under.)

This is to certify, that United States Bureau of Fisheries of Carson, State of Washington, has made proof to the satisfaction of the StateSupervisor of Mydraulics of Washington, of a right to the use of the waters of Little White Salmon River, a tributary of Columbia River, for the purposes of Artificial propagation of fish under Appropriation Permit No. 235 issued by the Chate Supervisor of Hydraulics, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perferted in novordance with the laws of haddington, and is hereby con firmed by the StateSupervisor of Hydraulics of Washington and entered of record in Volume 3, at page 1193, on the 20th day of May, 1939; that the right hereby confirmed dates from December 12, 1921; that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 4.456 cubic feet per second.
