I am the secretary and assistant superintendent of Spokane, Portland and Seattle Railway Company, a Washington corporation. As assistant superintendent, I have charge of the engineering department of raid Spokane, Portland and Seattle Eatlway Company. As secretary of Spekane, Fortland and Scattle Railway Company, I executed that certain flowage easement duted August 20, 1937, from Spokane, Portland and Seattle Railway Company to the United States of America. I participated in negotiating with representatives of the United States of America, which led to the execution of said flowage easement, and I am familiar with the property involved. An ordinance granting unto the North Bonneville water Commany a corporation, a franchise to construct and maintain in and upon certain streets in the Town of North Bonneville water Fipe mains and lines and providing terms, conditions and limitations thereof.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Town of North Bonneville.

Section 1: That there is hereby granted unto the North Bonneville Water Company, a corporation, a franchise for the term of twenty-five (25) years from the first day of May, 1939, to lay, construct and maintain pipe lines and water pipe mains in, through, on and
