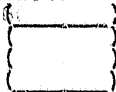

Certificate Of Water Right (For rights perfected under original, enlargement or secondary  
permits.) (In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 117, Laws of Washington for 1917,  
and the regulations of the State Supervisor of Hydraulics thereunder.)

This is to certify, that State of Washington, Department of Highways of Olympia, State  
of Washington, has made proof to the satisfaction of the State Supervisor of Hydraulics of  
Washington, of a right to the use of the waters of Unnamed stream, a tributary of Columbia  
River, for the purposes of Irrigation and drinking fountain under Appropriation Permit No.  
2787 issued by the State Supervisor of Hydraulics, and that said right to <sup>the</sup> use of said wat-  
ers has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Washington, and is hereby confirmed  
by the State Supervisor of Hydraulics of Washington and entered of record in Volume 3, at  
page 1233, on the 25th day of August, 1939; that the amount of water to which such right  
is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount  
actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.05 of a cubic foot  
per second.

A description of the lands under such right to which the water hereby confirmed is  
appurtenant, and the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:

Whereas, the said principal has been appointed Sheriff for Skamania County, State of Washington, for the term beginning August 7th, 1939, and ending January 8th, 1941, or until her successor is elected and qualified.

Now, Therefore, if the said principal shall well and faithfully perform all and singular the duties incumbent upon him by reason of his election as said Sheriff and not approve audit or order paid any illegal unwarranted or unjust claim against the County for personal services and shall honestly account for all moneys coming into her hands as said Sheriff according to law, then this obligation shall be null and void; it is otherwise to be and remain in full force and virtue.

In Testimony Whereof, the said principal has hereunto set her hand and seal and the said surety has caused this instrument of writing to be signed by its duly authorized Resident Vice-President and Resident Assistant Secretary and its corporate seal to be hereunto attached the day and year first above written.
