New York Casualty Co. to Max W. Beck.

New York Casualty Company organized 1890. Revocation of Power of Attorney #1045.

Know all men by these presents; that the New York Casualty Company a corporation duly incorporated and existing under the Laws of the State of New York, hereby revokes, annuls and makes void that certain power of attorney, dated December 12, 1935, whereby it appointed Max W. Beck, of Stevenson, Washington, its true, sufficient and lawful attorney with full power and authority to make, execute and deliver, for it, in its name and in its behalf, bonds, undertakings or obligations, as follows:

Bonds, not exceeding in any single instance, Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000), conditioned for the faithful performance of their duties by Executors, Administrators and Receivers in State Courts (excepting Trustees and Receivers under State insolvency Laws and Assignees for the benefit of Creditors);

Bonds, not exceeding in any single instance, One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000), on Plaintiffs' Attachment, on Plaintiffs' Garnishment, on Plaintiffs' Replevin, and Indemnity Bonds to the Sheriff (All writs or process other than execution after judgment);

Bonds, not exceeding in any single instance, One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000), for Notaries Public. and

Bonds, not exceeding in any single instance, Five Hundred Dollars (\$500), for Cost,-
