

W. A. Howe & wife to Jonathan Bourne, Jr.

This Indenture, made this tenth day of April in the year of our Lord, One Thousand Nine Hundred and One (1901) Between W. A. Howe and A. C. Howe his wife parties of the first part, and Jonathan Bourne, Jr. party of the second part, Witnesseth, that the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Four hundred and fifty Dollars gold coin of the United States of America to them in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, remised, released and forever quitclaimed and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, remise, release and forever quitclaim unto the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns

those five certain quartz mining claims situated in Township Three (3) North of Range Five (5) East of the Willamette Meridian in the Bull Mountain Mining District in the County of Skamania, State of Washington located and known as the "Apex", the "Summit", the "Barley", the "King" and the "Cuckoo" claims, respectively, the certificate of location of said "Apex" claim being recorded in Book "A" of Mineral Locations of said Skamania County at page 101, the certificate of location of said "Summit" claim being recorded in said Book "A" at page 207, the certificate of location of said "Barley" claim being recorded in said Book "A" at page 241, the certificate of location of said "King" claim being recorded in said Book "A" at page 253, and the certificate of location of said "Cuckoo" claim being recorded in said Book "A" at page 247.

Also that certain water-right on Chimney Rock Creek in said Township and range located and claimed by said W. A. Howe by notice dated and posted September 29th 1899, a copy of which said notice is recorded in Book "D" at page 315, of Miscellaneous Records of said Skamania County.

Also, that certain water-right on Larch Creek in said Township and range located and claimed by said W. A. Howe by notice dated and posted September 21st 1899, a copy of which said notice is recorded in Book "D" at page 317, of Miscellaneous Records of said Skamania County.
