L. O. Ash to W. J. Hamilton

Know all men by these presents, That the undersigned the owner and holder of a certain
mortgage bearing date the 30th day of August 1904, made and executed by W. J.
Hamilton and wife to the undersigned and recorded on August 30th 1904 in book 5 of
