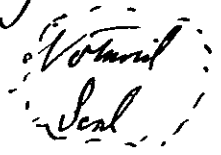

Together with the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining. To have and to hold unto the said mortgagee her heirs and assigns forever.

This conveyance is intended as a mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Five Hundred & Fifty (\$550.00) Dollars, in accordance with the tenor of a certain promissory note, of which the following is a copy, to-wit:
