

J. A. Gelfelt et al. to Copper Creek Mining Company.

This Indenture made this 30th day of June, 1900, between the undersigned parties of the first part, and the Copper Creek Mining Company, party of the second part.

Witnesseth, That, Whereas, the said Copper Creek Mining Company has been duly incorporated under the laws of the State of Oregon, and it is intended by this instrument to transfer to the said party of the second part, all the right, title, and interest of the said parties of the first part, which they, and each of them have, and claim, in, and to the mining ground and claims, or lodes, and appurtenances hereinafter described.

Now Therefore, Know all Men by These Presents, that the said parties of the first part, and each of them whose names are hereunto subscribed, in consideration of certificates of stock in said incorporated Company, heretofore issued to them, their, and each of their heirs and assigns, in conformity with the by-laws of said corporation heretofore adopted, do by these presents, grant, bargain, sell, transfer, remise, release and quitclaim unto the said party of the second part, its successors and assigns, all their, and each of their right, interest, claims and demands whatsoever, in law or equity, of, in, or to, all that certain mining ground, claims or lodes, situated, lying, and being in Copper Creek Mining District, Skamania County, and State of Washington, described as follows: -
