The said sum of money to be paid the Grantor by the Grantees in the following manner; the sum of fifty dollars at the time of signing this agreement and the other sum of \$100.00 at the time of the commencement of logging operations and the balance within one year from date hereof.

Time and exact performance are the essence of this agreement and the failure of the Grantees to comply with any of the terms and conditions hereof shall, at the option of the Grantor, cause the forfeiture of all rights hereby granted, however said failure to comply with said terms and conditions and the repossession of the property shall not relieve the Grantees from any claims for damages sustained by the Grantor by reason of said failure.

This is to certify, that Fish and Wildlife Service, Dept. of Commerce of Washington, District of Columbia, has made proof to the satisfaction of the State Supervisor of Hydraulics of Washington, of a right to the use of the waters of Little White Salmon, a tributary of Columbia River, for the purposes of Fish Culture under Appropriation Permit No. 2914 issued by the State Supervisor of Hydraulics, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Washington, and is hereby confirmed by the State Supervisor of Hydraulics of Washington and entered of record in Volume 3, at Page 1385, on the 4th day of September, 1940; that the right hereby confirmed dates from June 12, 1939; that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 15.6 cubic feet per second.
