"The President, or Vice-President, or Second Vice-President, or any one of the additional Vice-Presidents specially authorized so to do by the Board of Directors or by the Executive Committee, shall have power by and with the concurrence of the Secretary or any one of the Assistant Secretaries, to appoint Resident Vice-Presidents, Resident Assistant Secretaries and Attorneys-in-Fact, as the business of the Company may require, or to authorize any person or persons to execute on behalf of the Company, any bonds, recognizances, stipulations, undertakings, deeds, releases of mortgages, contracts, agreements and policies, and to affix the seal of the Company thereto."

does hereby nominate, constitute and appoint George F. Christensen of Stevensen, Washington, its true and lawful agent and Attorney-in-Fact, to make, execute, seal and deliver, for, and on its behalf as surety, and as its act and deed:

1. Bonds and undertakings for faithful performance of duty, each in a penalty not to exceed the sum of Fifty Thousand Dollars Dollars (\$50,000) as follows:

(a) Bonds and undertakings to be filed in any Court of the State of Washington, or in any United States Court for said last mentioned State, for administrators and executors; for commissioners, referees and trustees for the sale of property; for receivers and trustees in bankruptcy proceedings; and for receivers in equity;

(b) Bonds and undertakings for receivers of National Banks located in said last mentioned State, for persons and corporations exercising powers of sale in deeds, mortgages, and other written instruments covering property located in said last mentioned States, except Assignments for benefit of creditors.

II. Bonds and undertakings to be filed in any court as aforesaid, each in a penalty not to exceed the sum of Five Thousand Dollars Dollars (\$5,000) as follows:

For non-resident costs; for petitioning creditors; for plaintiffs in attachment, garnishment, sequestration, and replevin suits; for removal of suits from State to Federal Courts;

III. Bonds and undertakings for Trustees under Will and Guardians for faithful performance of duty, and to be filed in any Court as aforesaid, each in a penalty not to exceed the sum of Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000).

IV. Bonds each in a penalty not to exceed the sum of Twenty-five thousand Dollars (\$25,000) required of State, county, township or municipal officials in the State of Washington, whether elected or appointed, except those for Treasurers, Deputy Treasurers, Tax Collectors, Deputy Tax Collectors, Sheriffs, Deputy Sheriffs, Police, Constables and Ju tices of Peace.

V. License bonds, each in a penalty not to exceed the sum of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000) required by Statute of the State of Washington or by ordinance of any Municipality in said State, however, not including Motor Carriers' Bonds, Bus Bonds, Blasting Permit Bonds, Insurance Company Qualifying Bonds, Blue Sky Law Bonds, Warehouse bonds, Gasoline Tax Bonds, Commission Merchants and Live Stock Bonds, Real Estate and Insurance Brokers Bonds, Collection Agents Bonds, and Industrial Alcohol Bonds.

And the execution of such bonds or undertakings in pursuance of these presents, shall be as binding upon said Company, as fully and amply, to all intents and purposes, as if they had been duly executed and acknowledged by the regularly elected officers of the Company at its office in Baltimore, Maryland, in their own proper persons.

Certificate Record No. 4, Page No. 1599. State of Washington, County of Skamania. Certificate of Water Right (For rights perfected under original, enlargement or secondary permits.) (In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 117, Laws of Washington for 1917, and the regulations of the State Supervisor of Hydraulics thereunder.)

This is to certify, that Frank Konopski of Washougal, State of Washington, has made proof to the satisfaction of the State Supervisor of Hydraulics of Washington, of a right to the use of the waters of Deadman Creek, a tributary of Columbia River, for the purposes of Fish culture under Appropriation Permit No. 2754 issued by the State Supervisor of Hydraulics, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Washington, and is hereby confirmed by the State Supervisor of Hydraulics of Washington and entered of record in Volume 4, at page 1599, on the 14th day of May, 1941; that the right hereby confirmed dates from May 1, 1939; that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.50 cubic foot per second.

A description of the lands under such right to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, and the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:
