This Indenture made this 11th day of May A. D. 1901 between Frank Marble, as Treasurer of Skamania County, State of Washington, party of the first part, and George W. Taylor of Skamania County Washington: party of the second part:

Witnesseth, That, whereas, at a public sale of real estate held on the 11th day of May A. D. 1901, pursuant to a real estate tax judgment entered in the Superior Court of the County of Skamania on the 23rd day of April A. D. 1901 in proceedings to foreclose tax liens upon real estate and an order of sale duly issued by said court, George W. Taylor duly purchased in compliance with the laws of the State of Washington, the following described real estate, to-wit:

The J. H. Bush Donation Land Claim in Township Two North, Range Seven East of the Will Meridian in Skamania County, State of Washington

and that said George W. Taylor has complied with the laws of the State of Washington necessary to entitle him to a deed for said real estate.

Now, Therefore, know ye, that I, Frank Marble County Treasurer of said Skamania County, State of Washington, in consideration of the premises and by virtue of the statutes of the State of Washington, in such cases provided, do hereby grant and convey unto George W. Taylor his heirs and assigns, forever the said real estate hereinbefore described.
