Schock of the County of Skamania in the State of Washington, for and in consideration of the sum of Seventy five & ⁰⁰/₁₀₀ Dollars, to her in hand paid by The Oregon Lumber Company of the — the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge I have granted, bargained and sold, and do by these presents, grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said Oregon Lumber Company and to their assigns, all timber standing and growing on that certain tract of land lying and being in the County of Skamania State of Washington, and particularly described as follows, to-wit:

commencing at a stake at the N. W. corner of the S. W. ¹/₄ of the N. W. ¹/₄ of Section 1 thence east eighty (80) rods, thence south thirty (30) rods thence west eighty (80) rods, thence north thirty (30) rods to place of beginning and containing fifteen (15) acres all in the S. W. ¹/₄ of the N. W. ¹/₄ of Section one (1) Township N. 3 North of Range N. 6 East of Willamette Meridian, and all of her right, title, interest, claim, possession or demand of any kind whatever, whether at law or equity, of, in, or to the above described timber with free access thereto over above described land, and three (3) years time is hereby granted for the removal of said timber
