CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For rights perfected under original, enlargement or secondary permits.)

(In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 117, Laws of Washington for 1917, and the regulations of the State Supervisor of Hydraulics thereunder.)

This is to certify, that W. R. Nunn of Carson, State of Washington, has made proof to the satisfaction of the State Supervisor of Hydraulics of Washington, of a right to the use of the waters of Unnamed spring, a tributary of Greer Creek, for the purposes of Domestic supply under Appropriation Permit No. 3374 issued by the State Supervisor of Hydraulics, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Washington, and is hereby confirmed by the State Supervisor of Hydraulics of Washington and entered of record in Volume 4, at Page 1667, on the 8th day of September, 1941; that the right hereby confirmed dates from June 5, 1941; that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 of a cubic foot per second.

A description of the lands under such right to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, and the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the East line of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 29, Twp. 3 N., Rge. 8 E. W. M. with the South line of right-of-way of U. S. Highway #830 (Evergreen). Running thence South 340 feet; thence in a Southwesterly direction, 275 feet to a point, 340 feet due South of South line of Highway #830; thence North 340 feet to South line of Highway #830; thence following South line of highway in Northeasterly direction to point of beginning, containing 2 acres, more or less.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, excepted as provided in Section 39, Chapter 117, Session Laws 1917.
