Certificate of Water Right. (For rights perfected under original, enlargement or secondary permits.) (In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 117, Laws of Washington for 1917, and the regulations of the State Supervisor of Hydraulics thereunder.)

This is to certify that Purl A. Mulkey of Cougar, State of Washington, has made proof to the satisfaction of the State Supervisor of Hydraulics of Washington, of a right to the use of the waters of Gunnar Creek, a tributary of North Fork of Lewis River, for the purposes of Irrigation and domestic supplies under appropriation permit No. 2805 issued by the State Supervisor of Hydraulics, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Washington, and is hereby confirmed by the State Supervisor of Hydraulics of Washington and entered of record in Volume 4, at page 1729, on the 13th day of November, 1941; that the right hereby confirmed dates from May 27, 1939; that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.07 of a cubic foot per second.

A description of the lands under such right to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, and the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:
