W. A. Gray to Cascadia Mining & Development Co.

This Indenture, Made the 8<sup>th</sup> day of May in the year of our Lord, one thousand nine hundred and one, between W. A. Gray, unmarried party of the first part, and Cascadia Mining and Development Co.; a Corporation party of the second part. Witnesseth: That the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar of the United States of America, to him in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, remised, released and forever quitclaimed, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, remise, release and forever quitclaim unto the said party of the second part, and to its successors and assigns all the following described mining property situated in the H. H. H. H. Mining District in Kamania County, State of Washington.

The Monarch Lode Mining Claim, running South East crossing Polar Star Lode No 2, Fifteen hundred feet in length and three hundred feet on each side of center line N. 1 and the Discovery about six hundred feet North East of the Polar Star Tunnel entrance and marked by center line and corner posts and commences at the South East end boundary of Monarch Claim No. 1.

Also:
