AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE VACATION OF FRONT STREET FROM RUSSELL AVENUE WEST
WEST TO HAMILTON STREET AND INTERSECTIONS; SEYMOUR STREET FROM CASCADE AVENUE TO
FRONT STREET AND INTERSECTIONS; HAMILTON STREET FROM CASCADE AVENUE TO FRONT STREET
AND INTERSECTIONS, AND THE ALLEYS BISECTING BLOCKS TWO AND THREE OF THE ORIGINAL
TOWNSITE OF STEVENSON AND THE INTERSECTION OF SAID ALLEYS WITH SEYMOUR AND HAMILTON
STREETS:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF STEVENSON:

THAT THE FOLLOWING PARTS OF STREETS AND ALLEYS IN THE ORIGINAL TOWNSITE
OF STEVENSON ARE HEREBY VACATED, TO-WIT:

FRONT STREET FROM RUSSEL AVENUE WEST TO HAMILTON STREET INCLUDING THE INTER-
SECTIONS WITH SEYMOUR STREET AND HAMILTON STREET; SEYMOUR STREET FROM CASCADE AVE-
NUE SOUTH TO FRONT STREET; HAMILTON STREET FROM CASCADE AVENUE SOUTH TO FRONT STREET;
THE 16-FOOT ALLEYS BISECTING BLOCKS TWO AND THREE AND THE INTERSECTIONS WITH SEYMOUR
AND HAMILTON STREETS.
