Bush Donation Land claim, in Township Two North, Range Seven East of the Willamette Meridian, in Skamania County, State of Washington together with all and singular the rights, privileges, improvements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging, or in any way incident or appertaining.

To Have And To Hold unto the said Mary U. White and to her heirs and assigns forever; and the title to the foregoing described premises, and every part thereof I bind myself and my heirs and legal representatives to forever warrant and defend unto the said Mary U. White and to her heirs, assigns and legal representatives against the lawful claims of all persons claiming or to claim, the same or any part thereof.
