Signed, sealed and dated this 24th day of November, 1942.

The condition of the foregoing obligation is such, that, whereas, the said principal was elected November 3, 1942, to the office of Clerk of Superior Court of the County of Skamania, State of Washington, for the term beginning January 11, 1943, and ending the second Monday in January, 1947.

Now, therefore, if the said Principal shall faithfully perform the duties of her office as now provided by law and as may be provided by any law hereinafter enacted, and account for and pay over all moneys which may come into her hands by virtue of her office, and that she, her executors or administrators will deliver to her successor, safe and undefaced, all books, records, papers, seals, apparatus and furniture belonging to her office, then this obligation shall be null and void; it is otherwise to be and remain in full force and virtue.
