Certificate Record No. 4, Page No. 1924 State of Washington, County of Skamania. Certificate of Water Right. (For rights perfected under original, enlargement or secondary permits). (In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 117, Laws of Washington for 1917, and the regulations of the State Supervisor of Hydraulics thereunder.)

This is to certify, that Paul C. Allen of Home Valley, State of Washington, has made proof to the satisfaction of the State Supervisor of Hydraulics of Washington, of a right to the use of the waters of Unnamed Stream, a tributary of Collins Creek, for the purposes of domestic supply, lawn and garden irrigation and fire protection under Appropriation Permit No. 3643, issued by the State Supervisor of Hydraulics, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Washington, and is hereby confirmed by the State Supervisor of Hydraulics of Washington and entered of record in Volume 4, at page 1924, on the 17th day of May, 1943, that the right hereby confirmed dates from December 18, 1942; that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.03 of a cubic foot per second.

A description of the lands under such right to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, and the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:
