This Indenture made this 22^d day of June, A.D. 1901, between Frank Marble, as Treasurer of Skamania County, State of Washington, party of the first part, and Turner F. Levens, party of the second part:

Witnesseth, that, whereas at a public sale of real estate held on the 22^d day of June, A.D. 1901, pursuant to a real estate tax judgment entered in the Superior Court of the County of Skamania on the 6th day of June, A.D. 1901, in proceedings to foreclose tax liens upon real estate and an order of sale duly issued by said court, Turner F. Levens duly purchased in compliance with the laws of the State of Washington, the following described real estate, to wit:

Four (4) acres on the East side of Lot Eight (8) Section Twenty-five (25) Township Two (2) North Range Six (6) East of the Willamette Meridian, and that said Turner F. Levens has complied with the laws of the State of Washington necessary to entitle him to a deed for said real estate.

Now, Therefore, know ye, that I, Frank Marble, County Treasurer of said Skamania County, State of Washington, in consideration of the premises and by virtue of the statutes of the State of Washington in such cases provided, do hereby grant and convey unto Turner F. Levens, his heirs and assigns, forever the said real estate hereinbefore described.
