And, Whereas in pursuance of said mortgage or deed of trust, dated on the first day of July, 1879, said Oregon Railway & Navigation Company did also make, execute and deliver to the said Farmers Loan & Trust Company as Trustee, a second instrument of further assurance conveying to the Farmers Loan & Trust Company upon the trusts therein contained in said original mortgage, or deed of trust, certain steamships, steamboats and vessels described in said second instrument of further assurance, said second instrument of further assurance being filed and recorded in the office at Portland Oregon, of the Collector of Customs of the United States for the District of Willamette in volume "A" at pages 286 to 332; in the records of Blotted Mortgages of Skamania County, Territory (now State) of Washington at pages 45 to 143 of book "16"; in the records of Blotted Mortgages of Walla Walla County, Territory (now State) of Washington at page 49 of book "6"; in the record of Blotted mortgages of Columbia County, Territory (now State) of Washington at pages 591 to 642 of book "8"; in the records of Blotted mortgages of Whitman County, Territory (now State) of Washington in book "B"; and, Whereas, the Oregon Railway & Navigation Company and its successors in interest in all of said property, The Oregon Railroad & Navigation Company, have fully complied with all of the terms and conditions of said mortgage or deed of trust, dated the first day of July, 1879, and are by the terms of said mortgage, or deed of trust, now entitled to have said mortgage or deed of trust and said two instruments of further assurance dated the first day of September, 1880, and each of them satisfied and discharged.
