KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS; That I, JOHN ELI MOSELEY, of Seattle, King County, Washington, of the age of 30 years, considering the uncertainty of life and being of sound and disposing mind and memory, and not acting under duress, menace, fraud, or undue influence of any person whomsoever, do make, publish and declare this my last WILL AND TESTAMENT;

FIRST: I order and direct that all of my just debts be paid by my executrix hereinafter named, with convenient speed, and within one year after the notice to creditors shall have been published by her.

SECOND: I hereby expressly provide, order and direct that all of the estate of which may be possessed at the time of may death shall be settled by my executrix hereinafter named without the intervention of any court, and in such manner as she may deem advisable, with full power to sell and convey any or all of the real estate or personal property belonging to my estate, without an order of any court for that purpose, and without notice or confirmation, at such price and upon such terms as to her may seem just; that no letters testamentary or of administration or bond of any kind shall be required of my said executrix hereinafter named, upon the sale of real estate or otherwise, except as expressly required by law; and that after the probate of this will and the filing of an inventory and publication of notice to creditors as required by existing laws, all of my estate shall be held, managed and settled without the intervention of any court; and that all rents, issues and profits derived therefrom, as well as the proceeds arising from the sale thereof, and all increment of the same, shall be held and managed by the said executrix as trustee for the persons, uses and purposes hereinafter specified.

Third: I give and bequeath to each child that may hereafter be born to me the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar to be paid by my executrix upon the probating of this will.

FOURTH: I give, devise and bequeath to my wife, MESSIE YALE MOSELEY all of the remainder of my property, both personal and real, of every kind and nature, remaining after the payment of my just debts to have and to hold as her separate property free and clear of all claims of every kind and nature.

LASTLY: I hereby nominate and appoint BESSIE YALE MOSELEY, my wife, as the executrix of this, my last Will and Testament, to serve without bond or the intervention of any court, as hereinbefore more fully specified, and hereby revoke all former wills by me made.
